Eid Ul-Adha Announcement 1446 H/2025 CE

As Salaam Alaikum,

The Ramadan and Eid Announcement Committee in Houston is pleased to announce that Wednesday, May 28 is the 1st of Dhul Hijjah, Thursday, June 5, 2025, will be the Day of Arafah, and **Friday, June 6, will be Eid al-Adha**, with the Days of Tashreeq being the three days that follow.

This announcement is based on the confirmed sighting of the crescent moon of Dhu al-Hijjah in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.
